

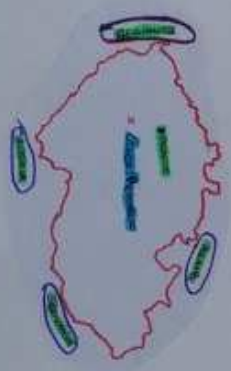
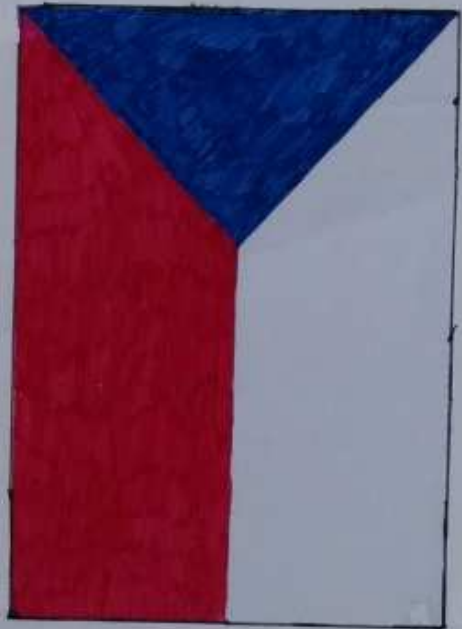
THE CZECH REPUBLIC

CLIMATE

THE CLIMATE OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC IS HEAVILY INFLUENCED BY CONTINENTAL CLIMATE AND IS CHARACTERIZED BY DRY WINTERS AND HOT SUMMERS. THE WINTER MONTHS ARE ONLY COLD, BUT WITHOUT MUCH SNOW. THE SUMMER MONTHS ARE WARM AND SUNNY. THE CLIMATE IS HEAVILY INFLUENCED BY THE NEARBY OCEAN. THE WINTER MONTHS ARE ONLY COLD, BUT WITHOUT MUCH SNOW. THE SUMMER MONTHS ARE WARM AND SUNNY. THE TERRITORY

THE CZECH REPUBLIC IS BORDERED TO THE NORTH BY POLAND, TO THE EAST BY SLOVAKIA, TO THE SOUTH BY AUSTRIA TO THE WEST AND WEST-EAST BY GERMANY. THE TERRITORY IS CHARACTERIZED BY LOW MOUNTAINS, THE SOFT HILLS ARE THE MOST IMPORTANT. THE ONE MOUNTAIN, THE SUDETES MOUNTAIN RANGE, THE HIGHEST MOUNTAIN IN THE COUNTRY IS THE SNYŽKA. THE BOHEMIAN FOREST AND THE CHAM OF THE WHITE MOUNTAINS. TO THE SOUTH-EAST LIES THE PLAIN OF THE MORAVIAN CATCHMENT. TO THE WEST - WEST OF BOHEMIA, WITH THE RIVERS ELBE, MOHAVA AND VLTAVA BASIN IS WHERE THE COUNTRY'S CLIMATE IS CONTRASTING WITH RIVERS THAT CAUSE FLOODS OF THE RIVERS.



THE TERRITORY IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC WITH SLIGHTLY HIGHER IN NUMBER OF THE COUNTRIES OF GERMANY AND AUSTRIA. HOWEVER, THE QUANTITY OF WATERS IS SIGNIFICANTLY LESS THAN IN POLAND. THE MOST IMPORTANT RIVERS ARE THE ELBE, MOHAVA AND VLTAVA.
